About Camp

At the Scott Mission Camp we want all children to experience the love of Christ in a Christian camp setting no matter what the financial restraints of their families. All of our camp spaces are reserved for children from lower income families. We do this in an effort to provide camp experiences for families that couldn't otherwise afford to send their children to a camp.

The camp setting provides a much-needed escape from the busy and hectic life of the city. If you live in the Toronto area and are between the ages of 7-19 we encourage you to apply for one of our summer camp spaces. Get ready to have fun, be loved, and be changed.

Campers can learn important social and life skills as they develop friendships with other campers and counsellors in a positive, caring environment where the love of Christ is demonstrated through words and actions.

Each child that qualifies has the opportunity to attend SMC for one session. Transportation is provided to and from Toronto. The Scott Mission Camp is a 100 acre property in Caledon, Ontario. There are bike trails, beautiful forests, large sports fields, a swimming pool, a basketball court, a playground, a pond, high and low ropes courses and a climbing wall.

Location:

Our camp is located on a 100-acre property in Caledon, Ontario and provides the perfect place for kids to unwind and enjoy themselves. We are nestled in the rolling countryside of the Caledon Hills, enjoying the beauty of the Niagara Escarpment and Oak Ridges Moraine. Caledon is a 1 hour drive north-west of downtown Toronto and is about 20 minutes directly north of Brampton.

Registration Process:

Parents/guardians must complete a registration form and a medical form for each child to begin the registration process. Incomplete application forms will be returned for completion. Campers will be accepted based on their family's financial situation and space available in the session requested. If space is not available, your child will be placed on a waiting list and you will be contacted if an opening becomes available. You will receive a confirmation letter within approx. 4-5 weeks of submitting your application forms.

Camp Fees:

Scott Mission Camp charges a highly subsidized fee for each camper based on your family income. This fee covers only a small portion of the expenses incurred by The Scott Mission to offer a summer camp program.

The remainder of the camp expenses is covered by generous donations from private individuals and companies. Camp fees must be paid promptly to ensure you will not lose your space. If you are unable to pay your fees for any reason, please contact the camp office to make alternate arrangements.

Commitment to Safety:

The health and safety of all campers and staff is one of the top priorities at the Scott Mission Camp. That's why we ensure that all of our staff are thoroughly screened and trained before working at camp. All staff must have current first aid and CPR training and must provide a criminal reference check annually. Each summer we hire a qualified Health Care Co-ordinator who is responsible for the medical concerns of all on camp property. We also hire Bronze Cross and NLS lifeguards for our swimming area and canoeing area. Our full-time, year-round management team is serious about serving God and determined to provide the best possible experience for our guests. Scott Mission Camp is a member of the Ontario Camping Association and as such is required to adhere to many standards of operation.
